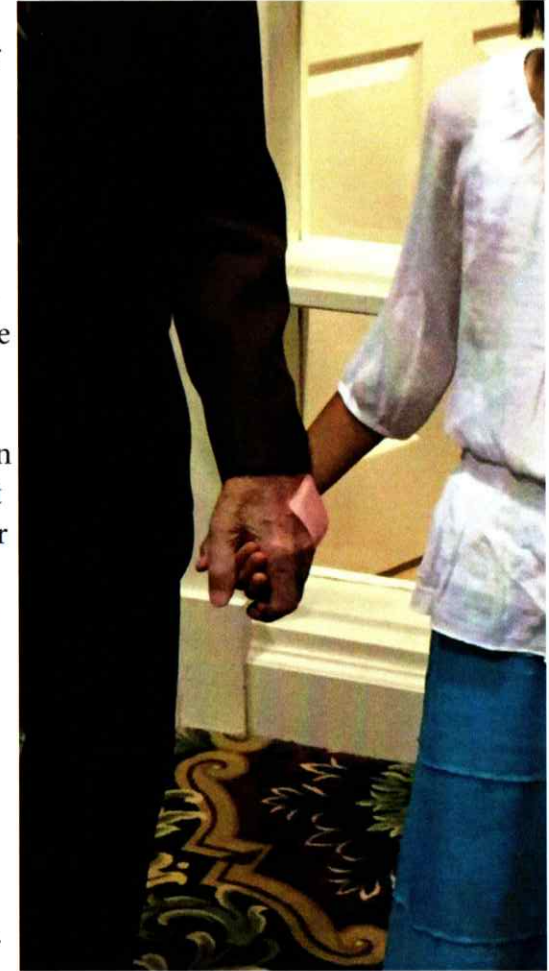

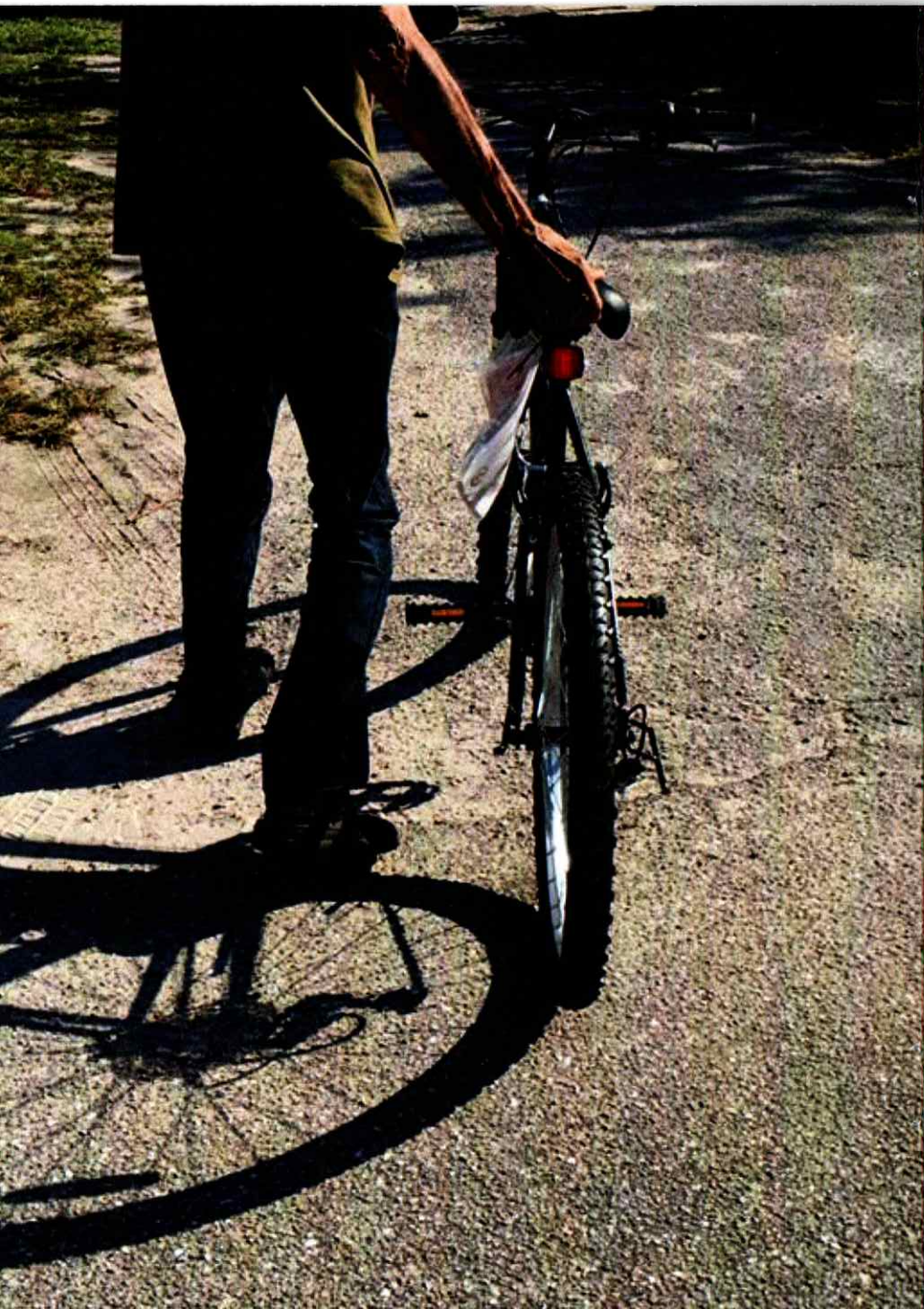
In a world of the Internet, text messaging, and social media, it seems like our connection to people have diminished if it's not coming from

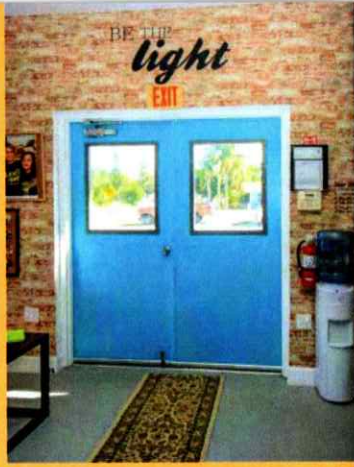

As we moves forward, we look forward to developing and strengthening our community of hope; volunteers and friends in our community.

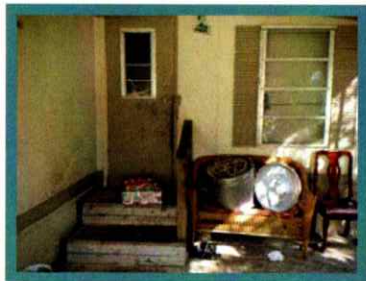


Together, we are the LIGHT and now is our time to SHINE!

We touched and met the needs of

- 2,710 students who fell below poverty level
- 109 birth certificates submitted
- 17 adults received new glasses
- 21 children received new glasses
- 43 Greyhound bus tickets were purchased with shared cost through our donors
- 2 airline tickets for our homeless to move with housing, jobs and vehicle provided by ELev8hope
- 9 student cremations were paid
- 1 student burial was paid for
- 12 private infant adoptions - preventing birth mom from aborting
- 2 home makeovers done for cancer patients
- 49 homeless families moved into a place
- 17 of our homeless/needy families were found employment
- 610 household appliances were delivered
- 700 Frozen whole Turkeys were delivered to trailer homes the night before Thanksgiving
- 560 premade Thanksgiving meals from Big Heart Brigade was delivered to homeless/ needy families on Thanksgiving
- 37 families were delivered live Christmas trees
- 47 recovering addicts were provided Christmas meal and gifts at their Sober Homes
- 51 Homeless clients were given gift cards to eat at a restaurant on Christmas and holiday gifts
- 17 battered women were given 1st, last and security for housing to start over along with a beauty makeover
- 4 cars were donated to struggling women and 1 male student who had no transportation
- 3 college tuitions were paid for kids whose parents were in prison
- 127 trailers were completely furnished by our students helping build up struggling families
- 600 lbs of animal food donated
- 535 jars of peanut butter and jelly distributed
- 37 animals spayed/neutered
- 32 students received scholarships to play sports
- 81 were introduced to a church
- 17 clients received drivers license
- 1,630 students signed their Organ Donation forms and checked Organ donor on their license
