These were the good days when we could spend time with the children. Now it is too dangerous to travel to Haiti. Even the border from Haiti to Dominican Republic remains closed.

Good news from My Father's House - school has started back, extra money has been sent so Pastor Predestin can start preparing for the Christmas party and buying gifts. All the children are safe. The younger children are taught inside the walls of the orphanage. The rooms are not fancy but adequate. Since there is no electricity, the only light and ventilation comes from small windows. The teachers work for very little pay. Some of the older children are in schools outside and must be very careful in their transportation. You will see some pictures of them in this newsletter.

I recently spoke in two churches that donated money for Christmas expenses. One was a senior luncheon at Lupton Drive Baptist in Chattanooga, TN that gave \$500, and the other was a senior luncheon at Second Baptist in Warner Robins, GA. I was invited by Gary Morton to share about our mission work at My Father's House and a nice offering was sent. Also, as they have for many years, Nettles Island Church sent a very generous offering for Christmas. Please be a voice for the children by telling your pastor about the needs of the children at the orphanage.

As I write this letter, I have a very heavy heart for God's chosen people in Israel as they defend their country from a terrorist group who murdered babies and are trying to kill as many Jewish people as they can. The question I ask is "how can we ask a Holy God to bless and protect our country when many people here are doing the same thing".
